Diflucan (Fluconazole)

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Fluconazole is used to treat vaginal yeast infections.

Fluconazole should NOT be used if:

- You are pregnant or breastfeeding
- You are taking allergy medications, blood thinners, herbal supplements, seizure medication, medications for TB, or diabetes medication.
- You have had a kidney transplant.
- Tell your health care provider if you are taking any prescription medications.

Some side effects of Fluconazole:

- Diarrhea
- Headache
- Nausea
- Dizziness
- Stomach pains
- Changes in the way food tastes

Use of this medication:

Take one dose with or without food.

Special instructions:

- Symptoms should improve within 24 hours, however, it may take several days for symptoms to completely resolve.
