RE: Antiviral Dispensing  
A/Novel H1N1 Influenza Vaccination Sites

The Central Michigan District Health Department is contacting pharmacies that serve our member counties of Arenac, Clare, Gladwin, Isabella, Osceola, and Roscommon to request their help in the dispensing of antiviral medications to patients diagnosed with A/Novel H1N1 influenza infection.

The Central Michigan District Health Department (CMDHD) is asking you to provide pharmaceutical services to clients that are prescribed antivirals by their health care providers. The antivirals oseltamivir and zanamivir have been distributed via the Strategic National Stockpile to a secure location in the CMDHD area. We are seeking partners that will provide the final distribution of the antiviral medication to the ill.

To join the fight against influenza, you are asked to sign up to be a participant in the on-line Michigan Care Improvement Registry (MCIR). The MCIR is a web based and secure information tool that will allow users to track antiviral medications and immunizations distributed by the Federal Government.

In order to be able to sign on to the MCIR you would have to sign a user agreement and be assigned a password. A MCIR agreement has been included for your information. Please contact the Personal Health Supervisor in your county for more information.

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In addition to dispensing antivirals, CMDHD is also seeking interested pharmacies that have vaccination capacity and would like to provide A/Novel H1N1 influenza vaccinations to their clients. Pharmacists will have to receive training in administering vaccinations. Pharmacies that elect to be A/Novel H1N1 influenza vaccination sites will have to participate in the MCIR program. Pharmacies that would like to participate in the administration of A/Novel H1N1 influenza vaccine should contact the Personal Health Supervisor in their county. If you choose to become a provider for the H1N1 vaccine, we will contact you when this agreement becomes available.
