
Isabella County Time of Transfer Program: 2024 Environmental Health Summary

In 2024, CMDHD evaluated **421 properties** to ensure that septic systems and private wells are protecting public health and the environment.



Wells: Safe Water for Most


 83% of private drinking water wells were properly designed, maintained, and supplying safe water in adequate amounts



Septic Systems: What We Found

- 81% of onsite septic systems were working properly
- 85 homes had systems that did not meet health standards
 - The most common issues were:
 - Damaged septic tanks
 - Undersized systems (less than 50% of the required size)
 - Sewage backups

- 25 homes had damaged or undersized tanks
- 9 homes had no identifiable system -possibly discharging waste illegally
- 2 homes had confirmed illicit discharges
- **5 homes** did not meet separation distance between well and septic



CMDHD's Environmental Health staff continue to work with homeowners to bring systems into compliance and protect our local groundwater and surface waters.
