- Identify mechanisms to acquire resources to maintain network infrastructure (finance committee opportunity tracker)
- Identify sources of funding for projects to improve population health in the network's priority areas (finance committee opportunity tracker)
- Obtain additional resources for grant development (strategic plan page 18)
- Collaborate with other subcommittees as necessary

## Legislative

- Advocate for public health legislation that positively impacts Arenac, Clare, Gladwin, Isabella, Osceola, and Roscommon counties
- Educate network members about public health legislation at the local, state, and national levels
