"It's an excellent chance for individuals within our community to obtain aid as they apply for Michigan's assistance programs," said Steve Hall, Health Officer at CMDHD. "We encourage anyone who needs assistance to attend this event and bring all necessary documentation."

CMDHD is committed to helping individuals and families in the community get the resources and support they need. If anyone is struggling with the application process, CMDHD will have staff available at the event to receive free, personalized help.

If you attend, you should bring:

- A phone, tablet, or laptop to receive assistance with the MI Bridges website.
- Proof of age or citizenship.
- Proof of all sources of income, assets, bank statements, or other financial items.
- Proof of disability, and proof of insurance (if appropriate.)
